2021 - 2022 Tuition Information

Tuition is calculated by the number of hours a family takes per week and is charged monthly.

Example: My family takes 2.25 hours per week, our monthly tuition is \$105

Each additional family hour over 6 hours is only \$15.00.

Tuition is processed monthly on the date of your choice, 1st or 15th in the months of September - May.

General Policies

Tuition Information: Tuition is an annual fee based on 36 classes per year and charged monthly, September - May. This is an average of four classes per month. Some months may have more or less but tuition stays the same for each month.

Tuition is posted on the 25th of each month. You will not receive a monthly tuition statement from us. You can log in to your account at any time and update your billing information and view your account status and transactions.

The Dance Works will only send statements to delinquent or problem accounts to include declined tuition payments. Accounts that are not reconciled by the 1st of the following month will incur a \$15.00 late fee. Accounts that become more than 45 days overdue will be considered grounds for collection status.

Annual Membership Fee: A registration of \$40 for the first student and \$10 for each additional student will be due at the time of registration. This will automatically be debited from your choice of payment method. This payment secures your spot in your registered classes and is non-refundable.

Refunds: There are NO refunds given on tuition already paid. Missed classes are not eligible for pro-rating or refunds. Missed classes can be made up within two weeks by attending another class of the same or similar level, as recommended by the director. Once classes resume after Christmas break no make-ups will be permitted.

Cancellation Policy: In the event you need to withdraw from a class, we require that you give a thirty (30) day notice communicated via the withdraw form and sent to hello@tdwkearney.com. This allow us to effectively withdraw your student from class and adjust your tuition. The withdraw form is located on our website, or available at the front desk or can be sent to you via email. It is not sufficient notice to tell an instructor or leave a voice-mail of your intent to discontinue. Please note: Your withdrawal is not considered complete until you have received a confirmation email. You are responsible for the current month's tuition and are also responsible for all costume fees if you withdraw after December, 1st.

Recital and Costumes

Spring Recital: The annual Spring Recitals will be held at The Merryman Performing Arts Center with rehearsals and performances May 31st - June 5th. This is an exciting and rewarding part of the season and we encourage all dancers to participate. We release the Spring Recital details in March.

Spring Recital Costumes: The costume fee is charged per dance and includes costume, tights, garment bag and any necessary accessories. This fee is posted to your account on October 1st and is due in full no later than December 1st. Any costume not paid for by December 1st will be automatically charged to the card or account on file on December 1st.

Costume fees are based on level and are as follows:

The Works 2 & 3 \$60.00

The Works 4-6 Ballet/Tap Combo 2 in 1: \$110

The Works 5-6 Jazz, HipHop, Pom Combo: \$60.00

The Movement: \$65.00

The Momentum: \$70.00

All costume fees are NON REFUNDABLE after December 1st, 2021. Costumes will not be ordered if not paid for. If your costume fees are not paid by December 1st you will incur a \$10.00 late charge per costume.

Spring Recital Fee:

There is a \$30 per dancer Recital Fee and includes participation, t-shirt and other recital memorabilia. This fee will be posted with your costume fees. It is not due until March 1st. All unpaid recital fees will be charged to the card on file on March 1st, 2022.

Attendance and Recital Participation: Attendance and positive gains in class are directly correlated. Regular class attendance is very important; it keeps the entire class on the same level and allows them to continually move forward, instead of back tracking due to absence. After January 1st, any student who is absent from four or more classes will NOT be permitted to perform in the Spring Recital.

Recital Participation Withdrawal:

If your student is unable to participate in the Spring Recital, you must fill out the Recital Opt Out form. This is available on our website, at the front desk or you can request one to be sent to you via email. Any students who opt out after December 1st will be responsible for their costume fees.

2021.22 TDW Dress Code

Hair:

All classes require students to have their hair pulled back into a ponytail. Hair that isn't long enough should be worn so that it doesn't hang in the face. Ballet classes require hair to be worn in a bun.

The Works Creative Movement

Girls: Tights (optional), leotard of any color (skirt/tutu optional), Pink Capezio Lily ballet shoes.

Boys: Black Capezio Lily Ballet Shoes, shorts and t-shirt.

The Works Ballet/Tap

Girls: Tights (optional), Leotard of any color, (skirt/tutu optional), Pink Capezio Lily ballet shoes, Black Capezio Tyette Tap Shoe.

Boys: Shorts and t-shirt. Black Capezio Lily Ballet Shoes, Black Capezio Tic Tap Tap Shoe.

The Works Jazz/HipHop/Pom

Girls: Tights (optional), Leotard of any color, (skirt/tutu optional), or tank top with dance shorts or leggings. Tan Capezio E-series jazz shoes.

Boys: Shorts and t-shirt. Black Capezio E-Series Jazz Shoes.

Ballet and Pointe

Girls: Pink tights, black leotard (skirt/tutu optional), Capezio Hanami Ballet Shoe.

Boys: Black Shorts and white t-shirt. Black Capezio Hanami Ballet Shoes.

Tap

Girls: Leotard or tank top with dance shorts or leggings. Black Capezio Fluid Tap Shoes

Boys: Shorts and T-shirt. Black Capezio Fluid Tap Shoes.

Jazz, Contemporary, Advanced Pom

Girls: Leotard or Tank top with dance shorts or leggings. Capezio tan jazz shoes.

Boys: Shorts and t-shirt. Capezio tan jazz shoes

Hip Hop

Girls: Tank top with dance shorts or leggings. Clean non-marking sole tennis shoes. No jeans, or jean shorts

Boys: Athletic wear that's easy to move in. Clean non-marking sole tennis shoes. No jeans or jean shorts

*Sequin/Canvas shoes ordered through TDW are **REQUIRED** for recital.

Acro

Girls: Leotard or Tank top with dance shorts. No tights. Bare feet

Boys: Short, t-shirt bare feet.

Boys Jazz/Hip Hop

Athletic style clothes that are easy to move in. Clean, non marking sole tennis shoes. *Canvas shoes ordered through TDW are **REQUIRED** for recital.
